

RSL ANZAC VILLAGE

RSL ANZAC Village provides residential care at all levels to over 500 people in our eight care homes – Catalina, Connie Fall, Kokoda, Milne Bay, Peter Cosgrove House, Phyllis Stewart House, Tobruk and Wirraway. Residents live in single or shared rooms and share community rooms for planned daily activities, socials and dining. Meals are prepared on individual dietary needs. A personalised activities program is available to all residents.

Entertainers are also enjoyed in this area. A n extensive timber deck with BBQ facilities is located just off this area and is the centre of weekly BBQ meals.
